## Letter from Bernie O'Hara regarding Homestays

I have been travelling around in Indonesia for the past week having meetings and such. We have successfully secured a training program with the East Java Vocational Colleges for a 12-month period, from approximately the start of August 2019. We will have a group of up to 20 students aged between 18 and 25 studying a Diploma of logistics or a Diploma of Leadership and Management at our site in Dry Creek.

The students will study 40 hours per fortnight and will also work up to 40 hours per fortnight to gain a greater understanding of Australia.

Many of the students have shown their interest in homestays to experience the Australian lifestyle during this period. I am wondering if this may be able to be listed in the notices if any families would be interested in sharing their home with a student for 12 months. Having had the experience several years ago myself with a German girl staying with us for 12 months it is a wonderful opportunity and they soon become a part of the family. The students are aware that there is a cost linked to the homestay and this will be funded by the Indonesian Government and managed by Natwide Personnel.

#### Supporting an increase in the Newstart allowance

The SA Synod has requested that we share the following with you:

At the Special Synod meeting of 9 February, 2019, Rev Liellie McLaughlin and Rev Mark Schultz spoke about the difficulties faced by people receiving the Newstart allowance that is roughly \$160 per week below the poverty line. Members of the Special Synod meeting agreed that the SA Synod:

- support a letter written by the President of the UCA, Dr Deidre Palmer and the Moderator of the UCA SA, Rev Sue Ellis to the Federal and State Governments, advocating for an immediate increase (of at least \$100 per week) of Newstart and requesting an explanation for the disadvantage imposed by Centrelink and Housing SA on recipients of Newstart; and
- that the Moderator seek the cooperation of the leaders of other faith-traditions to assist in helping to recognise and highlight the state of poverty and mental health suffered by recipients of Newstart.

### Join the Oodnadatta Pilgrimage & Working Party - 24 - 29 April 2019

Moderator Rev Sue Ellis will be leading a pilgrimage and working party to Oodnadatta just after Easter. This five-day excursion is supporting the Oodnadatta Faith Community and the Reconciliation Week Pilgrimage of Healing Appeal for 2019. The Pilgrimage of Healing has run annually since 2011 as a part of Reconciliation Week (27 May - 3 June), supported by Mission Resourcing, the Uniting Church SA Covenanting Committee and the Uniting Aboriginal and Islander Christian Congress. The project offers support for the development of Indigenous communities within the Uniting Church in South Australia, and chooses a different focus each year. The 2019 focus is once again on the Oodnadatta Building Appeal. This faith community currently worships at an open air church and is in great need of a building. This is a unique trip into Australia's heartland. Anyone is welcome to join for a pilgrimage filled with work, fellowship and fun.
