The Restructuring Task Group have been moving around the Synod listening to the hopes and dreams people have for the new Presbyteries that will be formed in November. The task group have heard from ministers and lay people, chaplains and pastors, from these consultations ideas are beginning to form about future directions. At our meeting we will hear some of the task group's findings and reflections and will have an opportunity for further conversation. At the meeting we will also be discussing a number of proposals that the task group have formulated. The meeting is open to members of our congregation.
