### A Note from Linda

We are in the third week of our purple season of Lent - a journey of reflection and preparation as we head towards Easter.

We have introduced a number of images which you may find helpful in your prayer life:

- **Journeys:** Last week we talked about journeys ... we are all on a journey, a journey of discovery about ourselves - about where we fit in this world and what that means for us in a spiritual context.  
This Lent, hear your invitation to go on a spiritual journey – to a new home, a new life, with Jesus.
- **Rocks:** we think of the rocky arid region where Jesus fasted and prayed and was tempted. Are there parts of your life that are hard, rough, heavy, cold? Perhaps your heart?  
Someone wise pointed out to me that if you hold on to a small rock for a while it will warm up in your hands. You might have had the experience of sitting on a rock that has been warmed by the sun.  
I pray that as we follow Jesus on our journey to the cross, your heart will feel the warmth of the Son and be open to the love that Jesus has for you.
- **Star words:** Your star word may also be helpful in your prayer life during Lent. Perhaps it is giving you new insights as you hear God's Word and pray? Please journal any thoughts you have along the way.
