Week 4 31 <sup>st</sup> March	A seed needs, a child needs.....	<u>Tirntukarla</u> (sunshine, warmth, love)	
	Activity	Equipment	Explanation
<b>Introduction to theme</b>	Kaurna welcome “ <u>Niina marni</u> ” (You good)	<u>Tirntu</u> means day, sun, time, clock	When pronouncing Kaurna words, the emphasis is usually on <u>1<sup>st</sup></u> and <u>3<sup>rd</sup></u> syllables.
<b>Activity 1</b> <i>Fine Motor/Play dough</i>	Make the sunshine	Playdough(yellow), straws, pasta No flour? Punch holes in a box.	Into a thick round slab of playdough, poke straws, then thread pasta onto straws.
<b>Activity 2</b> <i>Fine Motor/Craft</i>	Make the sunshine with your hands	Paper plate, yellow paper, glue sticks, scissors, pencils/crayons/textas	Put plate (or trace/cut a paper circle) upside down. Trace/cut around hands then paste around circle. Add a happy face to your sun.
<b>Activity 3</b> Sensory/ Social  Green activities are more suitable for out of doors	Let’s read! Paint/paste a heart  Make a nature heart Wash the dolls  Cook on the fire	Library books, mat, pillow Glue paint/brushes(red/white), heart shaped paper, cellophane etc Sand trays, sticks, seedpods, leaves etc Shell/warm water, bubble bath, dolls, towels, tooth brushes, flannel/sponge  <u>Wardli</u> (home/house), frypan, billy, leaves, sausages	Set up your own cosy reading corner. Glue paint can be made by adding wallpaper paste to paint, or let paint dry, then paste. Make a heart shape in the sand, then decorate. Use a paddling pool or basin. Mini clothesline could be made with string and gardening stakes Make your own bush home. Sausages can be made with stuffed stockings/socks.
<b>Activity 4</b> <i>Gross motor/Social</i>	Cuddle a teddy  Dance with your shadow	Climbing frames/chairs, teddies, blanket, cradle, picnic rug, teaset Musical instruments in basket	Set up your own cosy corner.  Dance, chase and jump with your shadow
<b>Activity 5</b> <i>Snack</i>	Hello sunshine!	Fresh fruit (oranges/rockmelon, pineapple)	Put slice orange/rockmelon on plate. Place pineapple pieces around the edge.
<b>Activity 6</b> <i>Story/Music</i>	Songs: “The Sun Song”  Story :	To tune of “Farmer in the Dell” or any other tune you like. “The Bunyip of Berkley’s Creek” by Jenny Wagner	Think of rhyming words like light, night, bright and make up your own song.
