A note from Church Council Executive

Church Council Executive met this week to discuss a number of matters, in particular the implications of the relaxing of COVID-19 restrictions and how this impacts on our church community moving forward. A letter is being prepared for our congregation updating them on the situation. During this meeting Executive expressed its appreciation to Linda on the tremendous leadership and commitment she has shown during this time that COVID-19 has impacted on our normal church life. It has resulted in Linda dedicating significant number of hours to the increasing pastoral care demands, setting up the self-guided resources and the ZOOM on-line services, while at the same time being heavily involved in the establishment of the Medical HQ Respiratory Clinic and submitting an assignment as part of her study leave. Executive has acknowledged this has created a huge workload for Linda with her working many more hours than her 0.8 load. As a result Church Council has agreed to offer Linda the opportunity to take an additional week's leave as time off in lieu of extra hours worked during this recent period which she has accepted for the week of 18-24 May inclusive (next week). In her absence the services for Sunday 24 May will still be offered in both forms and will be managed by a team of volunteers.
