


Stay and Play @ Home Programme

Week 1 28 th July	Yitpi (seed), seedpods Tukutya (small) Yitpi tukutya (the human soul)	Where do you find a small seed? What happens to the seedpod when the seed is ready to grow?	Main source for Kaurna is “Kulurdu Marni Ngathaitya! Sounds Good to Me!” written for Kaurna Warra Pintyanthi by Rob Amery and Jane Simpson 2013
Activity		Equipment	Explanation
Introduction to theme	Kaurna welcome “Niina marni” (you good)	Some words have been accessed on English-Kaurna Warra Dictionary Online Free Translation	Remember the emphasis on <u>1st</u> and <u>3rd</u> syllables. Children love new words/sounds so have a go!
Activity 1 <i>Fine Motor/Play dough</i>	Make a seedy shape	Playdough, rolling pins, cutters, variety of beans	Cut a shape (heart, circle) with a cutter then cover with variety of beans.
Activity 2 <i>Fine Motor/Craft</i>	Make and play with a seedpod family	Glue gun or white craft glue, nature objects, box, scissors etc	See attached pdf. Use box or fairy house from Term 2, 16 th June for your family.
Activity 3 Sensory/ Social Out door/nature activities	Let’s read! Print with fruit Secret seeds Seed pod family goes sailing! Make seed pod stew	Library books, mat, pillows Paint, trays/sponges, fruit, (apples, oranges) paper Bowl of rice, wheat or beans, small objects Seed pod family, bark, water Old pots/spoons, water, seed pods	Set up your own cosy corner. Put a damp sponge in tray, add paint. Cut fruit to find seeds, then print with fruit. Hide objects in rice etc. Use an object theme-kitchen things (spoon, eggcup, scoop) Find a creek, basin or bath and sail your seed pod family in a bark boat. Play in the wirra wardli or cubby house
Activity 4 <i>Gross motor/Social</i>	Collect the rubbish/seedpods Tree hopscotch	Paper, buckets Chalk, seed pods 	Throw scrunched paper “seedpods” into buckets at different distances. Draw a “tree”, dividing the trunk into 5 or more squares. Collect a seed pod from the top of the tree each time you jump, hop or step up the trunk.
Activity 5 <i>Snack</i>	Circles of fruit	Apples, oranges, kiwi, bananas	Slice fruit into circle sand try stacking them.
Activity 6 <i>Story/Music</i>	Song-“The gardener plants the seeds” Story	To the tune of “The farmer in the dell” “The Tiny Seed” by Eric Carle	Make up your own words-plant, sun, rain etc You Tube, then search for The Tiny Seed by Eric Carle Christiana Hagan
