Holy Week and Easter Services

14 April (7.00-8.30pm)	Maundy Thursday prayer	A time for individual prayer. The church will be set up with a number of prayer stations focussed on Jesus' journey to the cross. There will also be a prayer station for the situation in Ukraine. Drop in anytime – takes around 30 minutes.
15 April (9.30am)	Good Friday service	A reflective service that focuses on Jesus' path to the cross and crucifixion.
17 April (9.30am)	Easter Sunday service	A service of celebration as we give thanks that Christ is risen!

Worship on-site - COVID update for congregations

From Good Friday, SA government mask requirements in indoor public places (including churches) have been removed – but masks are still strongly recommended in crowded spaces.

So whilst you are <u>no longer required</u> to wear a mask it is our hope that an individual's choice to wear a mask will be supported and respected for those who wish to maintain this practice.

Please still don't attend in person if you are unwell or if you have been notified by anyone that you may be a close contact. From <u>Good Friday</u>, you will <u>no longer be required</u> to use QR codes or fill in contact tracing records but you are encouraged to continue with hand sanitizing. As a church we are still required to provide a covid marshal and continue to clean frequently.

Worship Rosters for June - Aug 2022

Please do this by May 1st 2022 (After 1st May you will not be able to amend dates or make swaps in Elvanto for a couple of weeks whilst I'm building the new rosters. Once the new rosters have been released then I will open your access up again so you can make any swaps required). If you'd rather email your dates to the office then please also do so **no later than 1st May 2022.**

Inputting unavailability dates straight into Elvanto:

The simplest and most accurate method is for you to enter your dates of unavailability straight into Elvanto yourself. You do this by simply logging in, clicking on unavailability and entering your dates in the form that comes up and then clicking Submit. If you need help logging in to Elvanto, Carol can assist and set you up with login details. *Carol (from the Office)*

Paul has a passion for community outreach and in his time at Clayton Wesley he was involved with many programs and projects to build community, including Hope's Café, The Spire Community Garden, ESL classes for newly arrived peoples, an op shop, legal support for refugees and asylum seekers and emergency relief. Paul also has a history with the Schools Ministry Group as he was involved in its establishment in 1991 as their first coordinator.

Paul's partner, Jana, is a PHD student at Adelaide University. Paul has two adult children and four grandchildren and currently resides at Dulwich.

Swapping your turn on a published roster

For Elvanto users, please note that it is possible for you to make your own swaps or replacements using Elvanto. This can usually be done up until 2 weeks before a scheduled service.
