Church Council Report

Church Council update from Tuesday 26 April meeting

- 1. We have received a summary report from the National Church Life Survey that our congregation participated earlier this year. The summary report can be accessed through the following link -

- 2. Medical HQ has installed new toilets and fencing at their Respiratory Clinic. It means access to the rear of the clinic building is now through a gate that is locked at night and on weekends so anyone needing to access this area can obtain a key from the key ring located outside the men's toilet.
- 3. Melissa O'Hara has kindly volunteered to take on the role of Kitchen Coordinator so we can now commence opening up the use of the kitchen.
- 4. Even though Covid restrictions have been relaxed the decision has been made to continue our current practice of using the communion kits until such time as we feel there is no risk to resume serving communion as we used to do it
- 5. Council has agreed to allow AKWAK to use our church as a short term storage and packing facility in late June as they have been forced to move from their current location and they had no alternative option. Council has provided them with a short term solution.
- 6. Council has endorsed another Blessing of the Animals service to take place in October with a decision as to whether to hold it an external outdoor location or at the church as was the case last year still to be determined. Feedback from animal owners likely to attend could be appreciated.
