ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE CONGREGATION, 27 February 2022 – MINUTES

1. **OPENING**

The chairperson, Allan Amber opened the meeting at 10.45am and welcomed all present, including 6 people who attended via Zoom.

Linda Driver was invited to open with Acknowledgment of Country and prayer.

3. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

GENERAL BUSINESS

Appointment of Brian Ball and Don Brown as scrutineers. Carried

4. REPORTS

Allan thanked everyone for their comprehensive reports.

Linda Driver

- 1. **Acts2 Project**. Linda shared with the members present and on Zoom the foundation of Act2 and how it was formed by the Assembly Standing Committee in 2020. It is based on a conversation with all UCA churches and how three outcomes have been identified as critical to the future structure, practices and ways of working:
 - a) Creating an enabling environment for local communities of worship, service and discipleship formation.
 - b) Fostering a cohesive national character of the Church and collaborative ways of working across the Church.
 - c) Fulfilling the Church's legal, ethical and social obligations.

2. Report

- a) Theme of Report was one of being *Thankful*. There are so many areas of our Church to be thankful for particularly the Leadership of Jeff Dry and Council, our discipleship, our community outreach, our care, our Office coordinator and much more.
- b) Long Service Leave. Linda is taking leave from 22 April to 1 August inclusive which also includes holiday leave as well.

Allan thanked Linda for her service, and on behalf of the Congregation, wished her and Paul all the best.

Jeff Dry

Jeff emphasised how fortunate we are to have Linda as our Minister.

Linda's Long Service Leave – After consultation with Wimala Presbytery, Jeff has been in discussion with Rev Paul Turley. Church Council has approved the recommendation of Paul Turley to be the Interim Minister whilst Linda is on Long Service leave. *Endorsed*

Glen Luestner

Reiterated the Budget is a breakeven budget and how thankful we are to receive an income from Med HQ. Budget was formally endorsed. *Endorsed*

Allan proposed all Reports be accepted. Carried

5. CHURCH COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Allan thanked retiring Council members Sheralyn Robertson and Bob Stevenson and thanked them both for their service and contribution to Council. It was noted that Jeff Dry, Glen Luestner, Meg Edwards and Lee O'Connell were re-nominating.

- The **Nominee for Presbytery representative** is David Walker.

Voting slips were distributed, and each member nominated overwhelmingly received in excess of the 51% of the vote required. It was noted that **59 members** cast a vote.

All nominees were elected.

6. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Jeff Dry noted that Medical HQ contract is current until the end of June but very likely to continue.

7. CLOSE WITH PRAYER

Allan thanked everyone for attending, and Linda extinguished the candle and closed with prayer.
