John's funeral will be held at Brougham Place Uniting Church on Thursday 29th September, commencing at 1:00pm. Please pray for John's family and loved ones during this sad time and also give praise and thanks to God for John's dedicated service.

Safe Church Update

Last Sunday was UCA's Child Safe Sunday. A day that reminds us of our commitment as a church to ensure the wellbeing and safety of children and young people, to enable them to become who God calls them to be. This commitment to safeguarding young people is everyone's responsibility, and it is a commitment to care for both the children that are involved with our church and its activities now, and those that may be involved in the future.

How can we share in this role?

1. Speak up if you see or hear something that is concerning to you. Talk to our Linda, Victoria or Church Council members.

2. Go through the screening process. Everyone working or volunteering with children *and* those in a role of responsibility (Appointed Leaders) within the Uniting Church must have a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC). Depending upon your role, you may also require a General Probity Check or Vulnerable Persons Check, which is carried out at the same time. Thank you to those who are in the process of doing their checks at the moment. If you have questions or are unsure about something, please ask me (Victoria).

3. Undertake *Through Their Eyes - Child Safe Environment* Training. This helps to equip us to know how to respond to abuse and neglect. To make it as simple as possible, we are hosting an afternoon refresher of this training at AUC on Saturday the 12th of November. This training is for those involved in ministry with children, have done prior child protection training in SA previously, and it has been 3 years since you last participated. If you have never done the training before and are keen, or it has been more than 3 years, we can help you to find a training session that will be suitable for you. to <u>https://safechurch.ucasa.org.au/events/through-their-eyes-906-986-715-824/</u> to sign up for the training. There is a cost of \$24.65, with afternoon tea provided.
