Incident Reporting for Near Miss, Property Damage or Injury to a Person

Please be aware that we have impleted a new form for minor incident reporting. You will find this form next to the first aid kits in the store room (behind glass doors with curtains, off the auditorium). You can use this form to report anything from a minor or major injury or illness, a near- miss (an incident which could potentially have cause injury) or other property damage. Please remember to complete these as they are best completed at the time of the incident or as soon as practicable afterwards.

<u>Use of the first aid kits</u>: Please remember to complete the First Aid Register if you access the first aid kit, even for very minor incidents. If the incident is very minor e.g just a bandaid from first aid kit, then this record will serve as a incident report if the full form is not completed.
