# Flood Appeal – National Disaster Relief Fund

Uniting Church President Rev Sharon Hollis has launched a national appeal to support communities across Australia impacted by flooding. Victoria continues to be engulfed by flooding, with tens of thousands of people impacted across the state. Yesterday, flash flooding inundated homes and businesses in Melbourne and major flooding of townships along the Murray River is expected to continue. At the same time, communities in NSW, Tasmania, Queensland and South Australia have been impacted by the extreme weather. "We pray for all people impacted by the recent floods and those who are coming alongside them to provide immediate relief and care," said Rev Hollis.
