A Note from Linda

Niina marni?

This greeting asks 'how are you'?

and your response, Marni'ai, means, 'I'm well' - or 'I'm well nourished' - 'my tummy is full!'

I could also ask 'Na Marni'? I have learned that this means, 'are you all well?'

So, we say niina marni when asking about an individual's wellbeing and na marni when asking how a group is..

Speaking in Kaurna language is one way we honour the covenant we have with first peoples through the Uniting Church. Each Sunday morning we include an Acknowledgment of Country on the screen. We acknowledge the Kaurna people, the traditional custodians on whose land this church was built, and where many of us live, work and play. We pay our respects to elders, past and present. It is a difficult part of our past to note that these lands were never ceded. So we commit ourselves to actively work alongside First Nations people for reconciliation and justice and to learn more about the language and culture of the first peoples of the places where we live.

This Sunday morning in worship we continue learning from Jesus' teaching from the Sermon on the Mount (Matt 5:21-37). His questions encourage us to look deep into our own hearts. He gives examples of coming to terms with our anger, being principled in our relationships, and being true to our oaths and promises. These heart matters and Spirit matters turn us inward to seek how we can live closer to God's ways and one another.

On Sunday afternoon we gather as Messy Church, when we will continue to learn from The Lord's Prayer.

To remove a unavailability, select the upcoming unavailable times that you are now available for (by clicking on their check boxes), and select 'Delete' in the drop-down menu that appears at the top of the table once you've selected something. To perform the delete on all selected times click the 'Perform Mass Manage' button.




