The season of Lent is coming soon!

Our theme for Lent this year will be "*Where your heart is*". The theme's inspiration comes from Jesus' teaching in his Sermon on the Mount about storing treasures. By exploring Gospel passages about treasures and matters of the heart, we'll be invited to wonder more deeply about what kinds of treasure matter, why we store treasures, and the power these treasures have in our lives.
