CHURCH COUNCIL

Act2 Update

Act2: In Response to God's Call is the first Act2 report since the decisions of the 16th Assembly and the creation of the Act2 Project Unit and Steering Committee in late 2022. It emerges from one of the most comprehensive and ambitious direct consultation processes the Assembly has ever undertaken, drawing from a deep well of insight gathered through our engagement over the past six months.

This report includes:

- A summary of what we did and what we heard during the Exploration Phase (November 2022 to May 2023).
- A theological reflection on the Exploration Phase.
- An introduction to the Collective Discernment Phase (current phase June 2023 to November 2023).
- A set of directions for Workstream 1: Local Communities of Faith and Discipleship.
- A set of four different options for Workstream 3: Governance and Resourcing.

An intensive engagement phase will run until the end of November.

Church Council is working through the report in preparation for submitting a response. If members of the congregation are interested in reading the report and making a submission then you are encouraged to do so.

The Voice Referendum Polling Centre

Our church has been selected to offer a pre-poll voting centre for the two weeks leading up to the 14 October referendum. We will also be used as a polling booth on the Saturday. This should not cause any major issues as we have advised the Electoral Commission of our willingness to co-operate so that both parties are able to function effectively during this period. Our involvement in both activities will have implications for our use of the building during these weeks. Please note the following:

- We will not be able to access the volunteer office during this time. Locks have been changed.
- We need to limit access between 1st and 14th October where we can so please try to arrange any drop-in visits, jobs or activities in the church building outside of this period if you can.
- Sunday Morning Worship, Thursday evening worship practice, TOFs shoebox packing and mid-week pilates classes in the lower hall will be able to run as normal during the pre-polling period. However, on the actual voting day, Saturday 14th October, only voters and AEC staff will have access.
- Polling places may not display any material about the referendum not provided by the Australian Electoral Commission. This means that no political signage will be going up on our premises.
- VIP Cleaners have been booked to clean at the following times:
 - Sunday 1st October, anytime after 3 pm until late.
 - Sunday 8th October, anytime after 3 pm until late.
 - o Monday 15th October, between 6 am and 10 am (cleaning times return to normal).
