
Cake Stall

- 3) Once there, simply select the range of dates and times that you'll be unavailable, and click 'Submit'.
- 4) Your upcoming unavailability will appear in a table on the page.

Christmas Worship Rosters

These times are not yet finalised, but knowing who is available when may aid in any discussion and planning as the worship teams and council work to finalise this year's christmas services.
