Welcome to worship at Athelstone! Our preacher this morning will be Rev Ken Wright.

Scripture Focus

Ephesians 2:8: "It is by grace you have been saved through faith—and this is not of yourselves; it is the gift of God not by works so that no-one may boast." It is a verse that is at the heart of the reformation and at the identity, theology and culture of the church. But what *is* the gospel? The gospel... The Good News... is that we *have been* saved.

Because of sin we are separated from God, but God throws a life line to us—Jesus—and when we grasp hold of Him, he holds onto us and we are saved. We are truly among those who need saving because we cannot save ourselves and we need saving from ourselves. The Old Testament story... and the story of our world in strife today tells us we can't save ourselves.

It's the gospel we hear in our text today: "we have been saved."

For it was while we were dead in our sins that God showed his rich and unconditional mercy and lavish love to us through his Son. It was while the human race was unable to reach out to Jesus that God reached out to us by sending Jesus into the world, not to condemn the world—but to save the world through him.

Jesus kept the law for us perfectly then traded places with us to take the Father's wrath on our sin *for us* and save us from his just sentence of death that we might have his very own righteousness and experience his Kingdom come...

Totally undeserved: "by *grace* you *have been saved*." We could never do anything to deserve God's love, never contribute anything to life with God or earn a pat on the back from him.

We are not saved because of our kindness to our neighbour or by our service in the church or how often we donate to community service programs or by how much we put in the offering plate. We are not saved *because* of our faith as if our faith were a work by us that is pleasing to God; we are not saved *because* of any decision we make, or our piety, or the eloquence or frequency of our prayers.

Scripture tells us that we are saved by Christ alone, and we receive all his saving work through faith alone ... all to the glory of God. Thank you, Jesus!
